#### **Notes to Tuition Fees and Levies**

- The College's policy is to provide all-inclusive tuition fees and levies as much as possible. This assists parents in establishing the total cost for the year, reduces cash handling and minimises the number of requests for cash during the year.
- Levies include excursions, sport, swimming, text hire, graduation, student accident insurance, academic competitions, camps, curriculum bus transport, arts council visits, cultural activities and a general level of ICT access.
- The levies for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 also include the charge from the government for each child's mandatory participation in the National Testing Program.
- The Levies for Years 7 to 12 also include an ICT levy for the provision of ICT support for the 1:1 program.
