



MIDDLE and SENIOR SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Calvary Christian College offers part and full scholarships for students entering Years Seven and Eight and Year Eleven in 2015. The College accepts applications from students outside the College as well as existing students. The College offers two types of scholarships; General Excellence and Academic Excellence

Applications are invited from students with a positive academic record and a willingness to continue their studies at Calvary Christian College. *The scholarships of two to three years duration will cover full or part tuition fees.*

1 Scholarships 2015

Academic Excellence Scholarships are awarded to selected students, based on the results of the EduTest Scholarship testing, evidence of previous performance and must demonstrate qualities compatible with the ethos of the College.

General Excellence Scholarships are awarded to well-rounded students who demonstrate qualities compatible with the ethos of the College, and their contribution and/or ability such as in the areas of Arts, Sport, service to the community and overall academic performance. Applicants are selected on the basis of their application, supporting documentation and EduTest scholarship test results.

2 Applications

Academic Excellence and General Excellence Scholarships

Applications for General Excellence and Academic Excellence Scholarships are to be made no later than Friday 25 April. A non-refundable application fee of \$75 is payable to EduTest upon submission of the online registration form. Applications received after the due dates will incur a late fee of \$225.

The scholarship examination will be held on Saturday 3 May at Calvary Christian College, Carbrook campus. Please meet at the main entrance of the Administration building at 9:00 am. A school tour, morning tea and presentations from the Principal will be provided.

3 Terms and Conditions

During the term of the scholarship students will be expected to:

- Accept all conditions of enrolment at Calvary Christian College
- Maintain a positive attitude to their studies and conduct consistent of College standards
- Maintain a high level of academic performance
- Participate positively in the spiritual life of the College
- Participate positively in the co-curricular activities of the College

Students will also be expected to meet all costs associated with:

- All levies, including general, subject, 1:1 and co-curricular levies.
- The College uniform
- The Parents and Friends membership and levy
- Bus travel to and from the College
- Any optional activities not covered by the tuition fees or subject levies.

A copy of the 2014 Fee/Levy Schedule is on the School website. Levies and fees for 2015 will be approved by the College Council in October 2014.

Students who do not fulfill the above conditions may have their scholarship withdrawn.

4 APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Applicants for either scholarship must

- submit a certified copy of their academic record covering the past two years of schooling
- provide a reference or supporting statement (preferably from a pastor/ minister) and
- provide supporting documentation outlining the applicant's achievements, participation and abilities.

Applicants are selected for an interview on the basis of their application, testing and supporting documentation. The Principal will then invite applicants selected to attend an interview.

Following the interview, successful external applicants and their parents will then be invited to meet with the Registrar and the Head of Middle and Senior School to complete enrolment formalities and subject selection procedures ready for the 2015 school year.
